What do you need to bring to class?

A pencil, binder, note paper, hi-liter, and you must have the **SCHOOL BUS DRIVER HANDBOOK 82.7** with you when you attend the first night of class or you will not be allowed to return the next day.

***You must attend each class in order to complete the course.
No Exceptions!***

California School Bus Driver Requirement Checklist

In order to qualify to become a California School Bus Driver, you must:

- Be at least 18 years old or older
- Be in good physical condition (*no diabetes (insulin dependant), epilepsy or any seizure disorder, or high blood pressure (uncontrolled by medication).*)
- Have a good driving record
- Have a clean criminal record

Some things that will prevent you from becoming a School Bus Driver:

- DUI within the last 3 years
- Serious vehicle violations within the last 3 years
- Any crime questioning moral character (*shop lifting, petty theft, welfare fraud...*)
- Any felony conviction
- Any domestic violence or cruelty to spouse/child conviction
- Any assault conviction
